### **Project SeSAFE**

SeSAFE is an online safety-training program that incorporates the key elements of a safety management system (SMS) .SeSAFE can be used as part of an induction program or ongoing training.

The SeSAFE learning management system (LMS) is comprised of modules addressing risk assessment, emergency procedures, personal and operational safety. SeSAFE now includes fishery specific modules for prawn trawling and new fishery specific modules are under development.
